

Silent Auction Rules & Information

The TATC Silent Auction will be held from 7:30 PM to 8:15 PM.

DONORS: Fill out your bid sheet then take your item(s) and completed bid sheet(s) and place them on a table near or attached to your item for all to see.

BIDDERS: Bidding must begin with the stated minimum bid. Silent bids must increase previous bid by the stipulated minimum increase or the bid will be invalid. Bids must be made by adults only.

To place a bid, write your first and last name and your bid amount on the first available line on the bid sheet that represents the item in which you are interested. Bidders will continue in this manner until the end of the auction. The highest bid will win.

The bidding will close at approximately 8:15 PM. Periodically, items will may be announced as “closed” and pulled from the floor and awarded to the highest bidder at that time. This will keep the bidding lively!

Item winners will be announced after all the bid sheets are collected and processed. Payment and item pick-up will immediately follow the auction. Auction item payment can be made with a cash or check made payable to “Tidewater Appalachian Trail Club”. **No I.O.U.’s will be accepted.** All payments are due in full by 8:45PM. The auction judge reserves the right to give unpaid items to the next highest bidder.

All sales are final and no refunds will be made under any circumstances.
