<u>Tuesday Group - Paddle from Great Bridge Lock Park. (Chesapeake)</u>

What - Paddle

When - Tue, September 19th, 2023

Time - 9:00am with the paddle starting promptly at 9:30am.

Where - Great Bridge Lock

Take exit 291B off I-64E onto Battlefield Blvd South VA-168, go straight on VA 168 until the last right just before the Great Bridge bridge. Take that right (Locks Rd) and drive straight back to the Park, about 1/2 mile, inside the fence. There is a restroom on the left just before the fence as you enter the Park.

Description: Paddle part of the Elizabeth River near the Great Bridge Lock Park. Meet at the Great Bridge Lock Park at 9am for a 9:30 departure. There is a kayak launch and a boat launch. No fee! This is a new paddle for the Tuesday group. We will paddle from the Great Bridge Lock Park West on the Elizabeth River, exploring other connecting waterways off the main channel, including Bells Mill Creek. We will see some shore birds as we paddle: Great Egrets, Great Blue Herons, Yellow Crown Night Herons, Green Herons, Seagulls, Kingfisher, Canadian geese, and probably more! We will also see some interesting houses & boats as we paddle along the river. The plan is to paddle as far as the Veterans Bridge (route 17) and turn around and paddle back.

The Steel bridge at I-64 would be is another 4 miles, which is probably more then we want to paddle, unless we paddle very fast. Estimated distance, depending on how much exploring we do, is around 6-7miles. Bring your lunches and we will eat at the picnic tables when we get back to the Park. Bring kayak/canoe and associated gear, water, snacks, lunch, clothing for the season, sun screen. The trip leader has determined that the following safety equipment is required to be worn on this paddle: Personal Flotation Device.
