- 1. Welcome and Call to Order:** The meeting, with a quorum, was called to order by President Vann at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Proceedings of Previous Meeting:** The June 2025 Board meeting minutes were accepted without amendment.
- 3. Finance Report - Lelia** presented the Treasurer's report.
 - Our June financials show the club continuing to be in good overall financial condition.
 - Lelia, Lee and Andy met with the folks at Wells Fargo and have now established CD's for \$5K and \$27K for 11 months at 3.5% (we were getting 0%)
 - Balance: May closing balance is \$37,160.81 and the **June closing balance is \$37,501.09**. The Wells Fargo statement was not received prior to the Board meeting but all accounts in MoneyMinder fully match the Wells Fargo website.

- 5. The Lightning Round Report – BOD members' monthly status updates.**
-No discussion or questions on the topics reported.
- 6. Proposals and Approval Requests:**
 - A. Lelia proposed the Agenda for the July 9, 2025 GMM. The agenda was approved.
- 7. Discussion Items:**
 - A. Lopperfest #1: Lesson's Learn/What worked -what needs improvement? and Are We Ready for Lopperfest #2?" - John, Kaci, Bruce, Jim S., Rich, Lelia.
-Changes are being made to the existing forms. Added vehicle description and license plate numbers for trail leaders. Also added a checklist for the leader to check off items that they are responsible for, such as, checking in the Garmin and checking that they received the emergency information package.

- Lelia would like to be able to send a draft form to the NPS before Lopperfest #2 to meet the Park Service and Forrest Service requirements.
- John Sima will print extra dashboard TATC trail work signs for trucks.
- Things left to be done are in the hardest sections: Three Ridges, Chimney Rock and a root ball.
- Jim Sexton said there are 3 areas that need work around Harper's Creek between 0.2 miles and 0.4 miles. The trail is eroded and gullied out by the stream. He recommends sending a crew to go out during the Fall time frame to stay a few days at Harper's Creek and move rocks to build up the trail edge.
- Ticks are really bad on the AT. Need to make sure that you spray clothing and shoes to prevent ticks.

B. Picnic in the Park: Saturday, July 26...Are we Ready? – Catherine

- Volunteers have signed up to bring food and everything needed.
- 23 people are expected to attend.
- Catherine will order the fried chicken for the picnic.
- There will be tours of the Brock Center and people can go on a hike after the picnic.

C. ATC/APPA Awards - Lelia

- The 50-year awards will not be awarded due to low funding at the ATC.
- The BOD approved giving an award for members who qualify for the 50-year award. This proposal will be given to the Awards Committee to get their recommendation for an appropriate award.
- Bill Bunch will look into asking someone to write an article honoring the awardee in the newsletter.

D. Volunteer Hours Recorded – Lelia

- Realized that some of John Sima's hours were missing and we corrected it.
- Before September the BOD members need to enter their admin hours and work hours.
